Additional Note by Executive Director

Skim Milk

1. The number of children receiving skim milk was expanded in all countries following the reduction in the price of U.S. milk to UNICEF in December 1949.
2. The Administration's proposal for continuing food supplies in Greece, Italy and Yugoslavia in the second half of 1950 provided only for the original number of child food units. This is shown as follows:

3. With regard to Italy, the quantities available in stock will provide for the full number of children in southern Italy, where it is recommended that aid for feeding be continued.
4. With regard to Greece and Yugoslavia, the Administration believes that the need for skim milk is comparable. Additional milk to provide for the larger numbers would be needed from September on with the reopening of school feeding

Greece \$50,000

Yugoslavia \$75,000

Meat and Fish

5. It has been the practice to make allocations for meat and fish when the Fund had resources which it was advantageous to spend for such supplies. The present diet in Greece includes cod fish contributed from Canada. Italy and Yugoslavia are also interested in receiving such supplies. This matter might be left over for review in the light of any future contributions received which it would be advantageous only to spend wholly or partly for such supplies. If such a contribution is received in advance of the next Board meeting, the Administration would circulate by mail a recommendation to the Board.
