Subject: Memorial Tribute to Audrey Hepburn

I am happy to advise you of two memorial tributes to our late Goodwill Ambassador Audrey Hepburn and to invite you to share the memory of her dedicated voluntary service to the world's children.

Friday, 30 April at the United Nations (ECOSOC and Conf. Room 3) at 6:30 pm

Following the Executive Board session, UNICEF is offering a memorial tribute to Audrey Hepburn in ECOSOC Chamber at the U.N., to which the Executive Board Delegates, National Committees, the UN Ambassadors, Ms. Hepburn's family and friends are invited. This tribute is by invitation only, due to the limited seating available. To allow UNICEF and UN Staff to follow the programme, we have reserved Conference Room 3 where the proceedings will be transmitted onto a large screen. We will also arrange for some of the personalities to come to Conference Room 3 to address the gathering.

The centerpiece of this evening of tribute performances and personal statements will be a 20 minute film embodying the philosophy of Ms Hepburn's active support of children worldwide. Film sequences poignantly highlight her UNICEF missions from 1988 to 1992 to Ethiopia, Sudan, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, Mexico, Bangladesh, Vietnam, and Somalia, as well as public statements.

Among the personalities expected to make statements or to read favorite poetry selections of Ms. Hepburn's are Cicely Tyson, Barbara Walters, Gregory Peck, Roger Moore, Harry Belafonte, and Hugh Downs, as well as the United Nations Secretary General Mr. Boutros Boutros-Ghali, and UNICEF Executive Director Mr. James P. Grant. Musical performers will include Yo Yo Ma, The Tokyo String Quartet, Jessye Norman, Tatiana Troyanos, Myung-Wha Chung, Daisy Egan, Terry Cook, Pinchas Zuckerman, the Dave Brubeck Quartet, Henry Mancini, and the American Boychoir.

You are cordially invited to witness the Tribute in Conference Room 3 (United Nations 1st Basement) or to serve as a volunteer.

VOLUNTEERS will be needed for various duties, including some in the Ecosoc Chamber. Staff who are interested in participating should call Christa Roth at extension 7465 as soon as possible. Volunteers are required to be available for briefings on the 28th and 29th as well as for actual duty on the 30th as of 5:30 pm.

At a later date, the entire tribute programme will be screened in the Labouisse Conference Room, and all staff will be invited.
