RECOMMENDATION FOR ADDITIONAL
ALLOCATION TO YUGOSLAVIA TO COMPLETE
MILK CONSERVATION PROJECT

1. Because of the value and importance attached to the Milk Conservation Project by the Yugoslav Government, the specific allocation of \$250,000 made by the Executive Board for this project, has already been augmented, in agreement with the Government of Yugoslavia, by the transfer of \$580,000 from the Yugoslav unprogrammed balance, thereby increasing the value of UNICEF assistance to this project to \$830,000.
2. The contribution of the Government of Yugoslavia to this project includes the value of the new buildings, additions or alterations, installation and extension of existing facilities, local freight charges, and local labour services for the erection of UNICEF equipment, amounts to approximately \$6,800,000 or eight times the value of the funds made available by UNICEF.
3. The plans for this project were drawn up on the assumption that the Yugoslav Government would be in a position to provide certain electrical, steam and water fittings and equipment. However, as the programme developed it became clear that it would not be possible for the Government to furnish as much of this ancillary equipment as originally anticipated. The Government has, therefore, requested that UNICEF supply the additional equipment required to complete the project.
4. The current progress in the Yugoslavia milk conservation project is summarized in E/ICEF/R.81. The terms of the agreement with Yugoslavia including plans for a

5. The Administration has carefully reviewed the requested list of equipment, which is essential to complete the planned project, and recommends that an additional \$60,000 be made to Yugoslavia for the purchase of these items.
