Recommendation of the Executive Director for an Apportionment to

African Area Allocation:

TB Survey Teams in East and West Africa

Corrigendum

1. As a result of Executive Board action, the apportionment for TB Survey Teams in East and West Africa was reduced from \$230,000 (as recommended in the document) to \$180,000. The reason for the deduction of \$50,000 from the amount originally recommended is that the Board decided to approve salary and travel expenses to medical and professional personnel through 1956 rather than through the first half of 1957 as recommended. For explanation of this decision see the Board Report (E/ICEF/294, paras. 120-132).

2. E/ICEF/L.746 should accordingly be altered as follows:

Para. 1, sentence 1: Change to read as follows:

"The Administration recommends an apportionment of \$180,000 to cover salaries of WHO personnel for a one and one half year period (through 1956) for two TB survey teams, one to work in East Africa and the other in West Africa, and for supplies and equipment for the teams.

Para. 16:

Change to read as follows:

"The total cost to UNICEF of the proposed surveys would be as follows:

"Salary and travel expenses to medical and professional personnel (for 1½ years)	\$150,000
Equipment and supplies	24,000
Contingencies	<u>4,000</u>
