INTRODUCTION

Initially three zones along the Nile were targeted for this survey namely Lologo/Rejaf, Walang Walang and Mongalla. So far two zones were surveyed, except Mongalla which will be done in a later date.

PARTICULAR OF THE FISHING CAMPS

Eight fishing camps and 571 households (Fishermen) were identified. The boats and twines are owned by few individuals. Most fishermen do not have fishing equipments. They use these equipments on hired or commercial basis. Since there is an average of 5-8 fishermen per boat, the fishing activities are carried out in shifts. See the below table for details:

GOVERNMENT AND NGO'S INVOLVEMENTS

In carrying out this survey the monitoring team consulted the Directorate of Fisheries and NGO's like SRC, OXFAM and ACCORD. Both the Directorate of Fisheries and NGO's operate down streams except SRC that operates upstream at Lobonok. Whether down or upstream the fishing activities are severely restricted by security situation.

SRC has three targeted zones of operations, namely Terekeka, Mangalla and Lobonok. However, they have distributed fishing gears only in Lobonok area. Distributed gears are ply 72 and 36 of 500 rolls each and 1,200 hooks to 300 Households.

OXFAM has selected three areas of operation all around Terekeka. It's targeted to distribute fishing gears to 17500 households freely. Three households are to be provided with one net, the catches are to be shared among themselves. On the other hand ACCORD has been selling twines and lines to their beneficiaries whose number are not determined. The Directorate of fisheries has deployed her officials and workers with fishing gears in several camps down streams in the following areas:-

1. Kondokoro Island, Juba
2. Khor Waret (Mankaru) in Mongalla Area
3. Lake Bayak in Terekeka
4. Lake Jor in Terekeka
5. Lake Muni in Terekeka
6. Lake Buni in Terekeka

Various types of fishing gears are in use by different individual groups of fishermen in Bahr El Jebel State. The variation is due to many factors. One of which is the type of fish in a particular location. See table 2 for details list of twines, lines and hooks.

PROBLEMS

- Security situation restricts fishing activities.
- Inadequate number of boats to every fishermen.
- Inadequate number of fishing gears to every fishermen.

SUGGESTIONS

The monitoring team suggests that additional 2-4 boats be availed by UNICEF to each fishing camp. This will help those who do not have boats to be on equal footing with those who have. A cost of a boat is estimated at LS150,000 x 20 boats required will be LS3,000,000.

Attached are the list of heads of targeted household to receive fishing equipments according to the specification provided.
