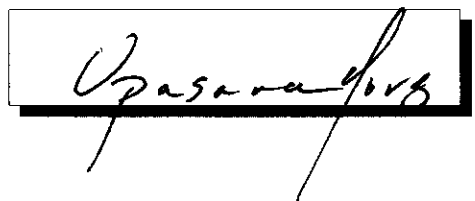

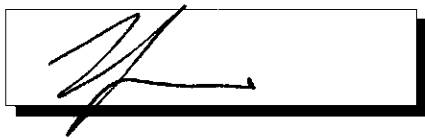

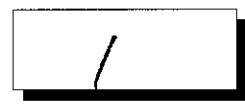

SARDAR TARLOK SINGH OF INDIA

Appointed a Deputy Executive Director of UNICEF

UNITED NATIONS, N.Y. -- Mr. Tarlok Singh of India is taking office as Deputy Executive Director (Planning) of the United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF), it was announced today by Henry R. Labouisse, UNICEF Executive Director.

As Deputy Executive Director (Planning), Mr. Tarlok Singh will be concerned with assistance to governments of the developing countries in furthering the systematic consideration of the needs of children and youth in national development programmes. He succeeds Dr. Edward Iwaszkiewicz, a Polish citizen, who retired last autumn after a long career with UNICEF.

Mr. Tarlok Singh served for more than 17 years until 1967 with the Government of India Planning Commission, where he was intimately concerned with the preparation of India's Five-Year Plans. He held a number of senior positions, including that of Member of the Planning Commission. Since 1967, until joining UNICEF, he has been Visiting Senior Research Economist of the Woodrow Wilson School at Princeton University and subsequently Fellow and Visiting Professor at the Stockholm University Institute for International Economic Studies. Mr. Tarlok Singh is also an Honorary Fellow of the London School of Economics and Political Science.

Mr. Tarlok Singh's writings include "Towards an Integrated Society" (1969), "The Planning Process" (1963), "Land Resettlement Manual for Displaced Persons" (1952), and "Poverty and Social Change" (1945), recently re-published in a new edition with "A Reappraisal" (1969).

Mr. Tarlok Singh holds a B.A. in economics from the University of Bombay and a B.Sc. in economics from the University of London. Fifty-seven years old, he is married and has three sons.
